1. Introduction

mybusiness is a premium HTML and CSS website template for yourself, your client, your business or your organization. This template has been designed to be as adaptable as possible, featuring an easy to use javascript configuration file, multiple ready to use layouts and full documentation to get you started.

The template itself is a fixed width which can handle either a single, two or three single column layout with a sidebar on either the right or the left or both sides. All code is valid XHTML 1.0 Strict and CSS 2.1 and has been tested on all major browsers including IE6, IE7, IE8, Firefox 3, Google Chrome and Opera.

1.1 Package contents

This template package contains the following files:

- 7 fully coded colour schemes (the HTML files)
- jQuery javascript library (jquery-1.2.6.min.js file)
- Front page slider (jquery.flow.1.2.js file)
- Javascript configuration options (custom.js file)
- Full valid CSS code (styles.css)
- Full documentation (this file)
- Working PHP contact form (contact.php)

2. Installation

To install this site template simply upload all HTML files, the /js directory, /images directory and styles.css file of the folder to your web server; it really is as easy as that!

3. Customisation

To change the structure and content of the page open the HTML files in your preferred editor or text editor.

All CSS such as colours and styles are stored in styles.css and are labelled and grouped to find using comments

3.1 Changing the header text

The first thing you probably want to do is add your site's name and slogan to the top of the page. Open the HTML files and change the text in the `<h1>` and `<h2>` tags within the `#header-text` DIV as indicated by the comments.

Wrapping text in `` tags in the `<h1>` will make the text blue, the default colour is red.

3.2 Adding, editing and removing menu items

The main menu is found in the `#navigation` div towards the top of the pages, indicated by the `<!-- top navigation -->` comments. The navigation is a simple list, to add items use the following template:

```
<li><a href="page.html" title="page title">Menu item text</a></li>
```

Add this *before* the closing `` tag.

To edit menu items simply change the text which is already there, to remove them just remove the whole list item tag (`...`)

To make item “selected”, add the class “selected”, like so:

```
<li class="selected"><a href="page.html" title="page title">Menu  
item text</a></li>
```

Menu items with this class will have a darker background.

3.3 The front page slider

The content of the homepage image slider is found on line 42 in index.html in the #slides div.

To add slides use the following code, add it to inside the #slides div:

```
<div>
  <div class="slide-image"></div>
  <div class="slide-text">
    <h2>slide #1</h2>
    <p>Fusce euismod consectetuer sapien. Fusce ac velit.</p>
  </div>
</div>
```

The content of div.slide-text will be floated to the left and div.slide-image will be floated to the right.

Be sure to also add a new span with class "jFlowControl" inside the #myController div on line 65, e.g.:

```
<span class="jFlowControl">4</span>
```

The number of these s in the #myController div should match the number of slides.

3.4 PHP contact form

This template package comes with a working PHP contact form found in contact.php

To set it up open the file and scroll to line 52 and fill out the variables – they are all commented to help you.

The PHP contact form will check to make sure an email address and message is given at the minimum before sending the contents of the form to you. The PHP form will send all values of the fields in the form so you can easily add more without editing the PHP at all. Adding more validation requires more work and is outside of the scope of this document. Please visit our forums for help with that.

3.5 The main content (columns)

The layout of this template can be easily modified to add multiple columns and sidebars.

A div with class `.column` will be treated as a column floated to the right with a width of 280px (by default).

To float it to the right add (note: not replace) class `.column-right`

The width of the columns is specified by the following classes:

`div.column` - width: 280px

`div.column-270` - width: 270px

`div.column-600` - width: 600px

You can use these on any div element to set the width. For a two column layout use `column-600` and `column`

For a three column layout use 3 divs with `.column` class.

See `index.html` for 2 and 3 layout examples.

`Portfolio.html` demonstrates a 3 column layout as well.

You may also want to use `.column-end`, depending on your set up, to the right most columns. This class removes any right margin or padding.

For a single column layout simply do not use any "column" divs - an example is in `terms.html`

3.6 Sidebars

There are two types of sidebars in this template - "simple" - as seen on `simple-sidebar.html` and "complex" - as seen on `products.html`

A complex sidebar overlaps the title area and has a background gradient; its HTML is like this:

```
<div id="sidebar" class="column float-right column-270">
  <div id="top-sidebar">
    <-- Sidebar content -->
  </div>
</div>
```

A “simple” sidebar on the other hand just acts like a standard column on either side of the template and uses the following HTML:

```
<div class="column float-right column-270 simple-sidebar">
    <-- Sidebar content -->
</div>
```

To float the sidebar to the left simply replace “float-right” with “float-left” and add the class “column-right” to the main content area (see inner.html for an of this layout)

4. Special classes

There are a number of extra 'special' classes you can use on elements which will give them different properties to the default elements.

4.1 input.formbutton

This classes is made for the use on submit and other form buttons but can be applied to any input. It matches the input with the rest of the style, adding a blue background and border and white text. See contact.html for an example.

```
<input type="submit" name="submitform" value="send message"
class="formbutton" />
```

4.2 img.fadeimg

An image with class of "fadeimg" will add an opacity of 0.7 which will change to 1.0 on hover. The initial opacity can be changed in the custom.js file – see 5. Javascript in this document.

4.3 ul.servicelist

This list provides a one-column list with icons. Icons are added using the classes. If an invalid class is given a question icon is displayed:

Valid classes, included by default, include image-icon, chart-icon, user-icon and search-icon.

4.4 ul.blocklist (within .column only)

This provides a “block” list whereby the link’s display property is set to block. You use a .selected-item class on an element within the list to make it highlighted blue.

See the sidebar in products.html for an example.

Note: This class requires a parent div with class .column

4.5 ul.nobullets (within .column only)

Removes any list style from the list applied

4.6 ul.contactlist

Similar to the servicelist, this list provides a pretty little list with contact related icons. Included by default are the following classes which should be added the of any .contact list : phone-icon, address-icon, email-icon. See contact.html (the sidebar) for an example

4.7 ul.pluslist, ul.neglist

Simple little lists with plus or minus icons as demonstrated on the index page. To use the negative list add both classes to the list like so:

```
<ul class="pluslist neglist">
```

For plus lists, just add the single class:

```
<ul class="pluslist">
```

4.8 div.redbox, div.bluebox

This class can be added to divs within the sidebar (and elsewhere) to provide simple coloured boxes as is demonstrated on the homepage, index.html and products.html

4.9 *.clear

This class is designed to clear floats

5. Javascript

This template uses some Javascript to provide better usability and more effects on the web page. All javascript files are stored in the /js directory.

There are 3 files included:

- jquery-1.2.6.min.js - jQuery, a javascript library so you and I don't have to write as much code

- jquery.flow.1.2.js – the code for the front page slider

- custom.js – contains configuration options (see below) and other custom code written specifically for this template

5.1 Configuration options file

Open custom.js within the /js directory to change some simple javascript settings.

Change the value of opacity to change the default opacity of images with class 'fadeimg'
